Ski Trip signups have already begun for the upcoming ski season. We announced three HSC trips and two CSC trips at our June meeting and allowed our trip leaders to make a short presentation with slides and

videos. As we announced in the June Flakey Newsletter, our selections for Long Distance ski trips for the 2019 ski season are as follows:

Mar 9-16 Big Sky, MT, Jim Randolph Trip Leader

With fewer trips available this year, there are fewer lodging spaces available. Winter Park trip is already filled but you may sign up online for the waiting list. Once reserved lodging spaces are filled, it is difficult to obtain additional lodging at the same bargain prices. If you want to ensure your space on one of these trips, I recommend that you sign up as soon as possible. See the flyers included in this Flakey and contact the trip leader if you have any questions. Online registration and payment is available this year for all our trips as indicated on each flyer.

Our trips this year include two trips to EPIC Pass Resorts (Crested Butte & Breckenridge) and one to IKON Pass Resorts (Big Sky). If you plan on skiing more than one week at any of the EPIC/IKON pass resorts, you can save by purchasing these passes. They are available for purchase from the tour operators. Also, Vail Resorts is honoring the Military this year by offering the EPIC Pass for only \$99.

Thanks again to our HSC board for supporting the Ski Trips committee and every trip leader as they execute the trip plans for next ski season.

The 2020 Ski Trips planning process will begin earlier this year. We encourage any potential trip leader to attend the CSC Fall Convention at Gatlinburg where resort vendors and tour operators will be attending and providing special package prices to incentivize ski clubs to sign up early. Our goal is to have our next ski season planned by early spring.

We will be staying in the Vintage Hotel which is conveniently located in Winter Park Village. This is not a ski in/out but the main Zephyr lift can be accessed by a short ride on a Cabriolet lift. We have Hotel Suites reserved for 30 people. Each studio rooms offer 2 queen beds, a gas fireplace (in most units), a television, a kitchenette consisting of a dinette/dining table, 2 stove-top burner, microwave, mini-fridge, pots, pans, coffeemaker, dishware, and a dishwasher. The property has a large, year-round pool, hot tubs, and free parking. This makes it ideal for families with kids, couples or singles. Families with kids only pay for lift tickets for kids if they are in the room with 2 adults.

Winter Park has a total of 3,081 acres of which 8% are easiest, 18 % are intermediate, 19% are advanced, 52 % most difficult, and 3% expert. The area is accessible with 25 lifts of which most are high speed quads which accesses 143 designated trails. If this is not enough area for you , then there are 1,121 acres of off-piste terrain.
